Redseed plantain can be harvested with a combine When harvesting redseed plantain, run the combine's cylinder speed at 1100 RPM, the concave at 6 mm, the sieve open 3/8", and the fan at 600 rpm To clean the seed, it should first be run through a Westrup brush machine and can then be cleaned further using a clipper style seed cleaner
