The words we've just added to the rhyme are some of the most common words that don't fit the first four lines of the rule In all of these words, ei makes the long e ...

**(ie) ei) (ei)**

If the sound is 'ee' it's i before e except after c If the sound is not 'ee' then it's ei This rule can be split into three word-types plus a very few exceptions which you may have to learn if you don't know them already • The sound is 'ee' so we spell the word with ie (believe)

i before e except after c unless it says a as in neighbor and weigh Basically, the verse tells you if the i and e come after a c, then the e comes first as in receive It also tells you that if the vowel sound in the word sounds like a long a, then the e comes first again, as in neighbor and weigh and vein In

**Some Tools and Rules to Improve Your Spelling**

Rule 1: i before e except after c, or when sounded like /ay/ as in neighbour or weigh • This simple rhyme helps explain the difference between the spellings of believe (i before e) and receive (except after c) In general, when the long /e/ sound (ee) is spelled with the letters i and e...
