suspensions. Black girls are suspended at higher rates (12 percent) than girls of any other race or ethnicity and at higher rates than white boys (6 percent) and white girls (2 percent). American Indian/Alaska Native girls are also suspended at rates that exceed those of white students.

2013-14 Civil Rights Data Collection: A First Look

- Black K-12 students are 38 times as likely to receive one or more out-of-school suspensions as white students.
- Black girls are 8% of enrolled students, but 14% of students receiving one or more out-of-school suspensions.

- Disproportionate suspensions of girls of color: While boys receive more than two out of three suspensions, black girls are suspended at higher rates (12%) than girls of any other race or ethnicity and most boys; American Indian and Native-Alaskan girls (7%) are suspended at higher rates than white boys (6%) or girls (2%)
